Add some holiday spirit to their toy basket with a plush Santa, reindeer, or snowman squeaky toy.


Why they'll love it: Soft, squeaky toys are comforting and fun —perfect for play or snuggles by the fire.

Why they'll love it: Keeps them active and strengthens your bond through play.


